**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF DEADLINES**

Defendant Energy & Process Corporation (“E&P”) and Plaintiff the United States of America (the “United States”) have filed a joint motion for extension of certain deadlines associated with filing responsive pleadings and briefing a motion to dismiss that E&P plans to file challenging the United States’ Complaint in Intervention. The purpose of the requested extension is to finalize a tentative settlement. The Court has considered the joint motion and concludes that good

cause exists for the Court to grant the requested extensions. Accordingly, the motion is **GRANTED**, and the following deadlines shall apply:

Date	Deadline
Mar. 10, 2017	Last day for E&P to file a responsive pleading or motion to dismiss and supporting brief in response to the United States' Complaint in Intervention (Dkt. 24)
Apr. 7, 2017	Last day for United States to file a response brief in opposition to E&P's motion to dismiss
Apr. 28, 2017	Last day for E&P file a reply brief in support of its motion to dismiss
